### English 8-12

Students reviewed Gerund versus Infinitives and prepared for Test 5.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

- We are reading "The Sugar Plum Tree" in Poetry and in Reading our reader is called Paths of Gold. We are studying the wind in Science class, and in Math we are carrying to the 1000<sup>th</sup> digit. We are listening to Christmas songs and learning the story of the birth of Jesus in Bible class, and in Art, we drew a picture of a teddy bear under the Christmas tree.

### 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

- We are reading Liberty Tree and also another book for our book report in Reading class. We are learning metric gram units and advanced subtraction of fractions in Math class. We are finishing Ch. 12 in History class and in Science, we are starting a chapter on sound and hearing. We are learning about verbs and their use in Language class and lastly, in Art, we made a December calendar.



## History

## Math

8<sup>th</sup>: We are learning how to evaluate algebraic expressions by using signed numbers.

9<sup>th</sup>: We are learning how to multiply binomials.

10<sup>th</sup>: We reviewed systems of equations and inequalities for Test 5.

11<sup>th</sup>: We reviewed the circle and took Test 5.

## Science

8<sup>th</sup>: We took Test 5 over Ch. 5. We are now learning about the water of the sea.

9<sup>th</sup>: We are reviewing Ch. 8 and preparing for Test 5 on Wed, 12/6.

10<sup>th</sup>: We are learning about adrenal glands.

11<sup>th</sup>: We are studying covalent bonding – sharing electrons.
